Posted UK to 1 address: x2=£30. x3=£38. x4=£44  
 5 or more @ just £10 each so 5 = £50, 10 = £100, etc

**JOURNAL-only**, instead of both magazines, posted (PDFs free!, from website)  
 • 1 copy of Journal --- £3.50, or Europe: £5.20, or rest of world £6.15.  
 • Subscriber: 3 issues of Journal --- £10, or Europe £15, or world £18.

#### Emailing ads

ads must be emailed: image or text

- ⊕ email image: camera-ready - attach your tiff, jpeg, PDF, we can stretch to fit
- ⊕ email text: just email us the words; you can also attach 1 logo to be included; we'll typeset, free (as we often do for smaller clubs)

✓ We use: Mac OS 10.13.6, Adobe InDesign CS 6.  
 ✓ Colour ads: you are advised to send us a printout so we can check colours.  
 ✓ B&W ads: send as greyscale, & check that before sending.  
 ✓ Jpeg ✓ Tiff ✓ PDF high-definition 300dpi, text 600 dpi, fonts embedded  
 ✗ Word: "Word.doc" is not an image! so save as a PDF → [Print] → [Save As PDF]  
 ✗ complex adverts may appear different - ask a professional designer to send

⌘ **Changes after deadline?** Possibly, conditions are:  
 ⊕ Adverts must be same size ..... changes by 30 Nov, 31 Mar, 31 Jul  
 ⊕ News must be no longer than previously sent ... by 6 Dec, Apr, Aug

⌘ **Non-Members' news** to FW Correspondents: 2 months (= 1 Nov, Mar, Jul)

Members: your club news - band - new album - festival - etc . . . your Reports, Dates, Festival Info, info on your latest album ...  
 What we publish is news from our Members who pay for this magazine. So Members' news about their album, rather than reviews.  
**MEMBERS' NEWS always OUR PRIORITY ... so no interviews, and no reviews (occasionally if space eg in correspondents' column)**
